

decoPINFIX

DESCRIPTION

decoPINFIX is a state of the art product designed to fill pinholes and hairline cracks. decoPINFIX is sprayed on the floor in between polishing steps and combines with the ground cement-dust to create a hard filler.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTION

Surface should be free of dirt, stains, fat, paint, loose particles etc.,

decoPINFIX is used when grinding with resin #50 (or resin #100) by spraying, the grinding should start before decoPINFIX dries. decoPINFIX will mix with cement dusts to form a paste and fill a pinholes on the floor. If a cement dusts which is from grinding is not enough to fill the pinholes. Cements should be added by shaking on the floor.

The repaired patches should be kept moist for at least 24 hours. Best method is to spray with water a few hours after the application and then cover the area with plastic and/ or wet jute.

After the repaired patch with decoPINFIX get hard, continue grinding with resin #100 to remove excess decoPINFIX.
